Qualifications to Vote

To vote in North Dakota, you must be a US citizen, a North Dakota resident for at least 30 days, and at least 18 years old on Election Day.

Voter ID Required

A valid North Dakota ID is required to vote. If you are a naturalized US citizen, please make sure you've updated your North Dakota driver's license or non-driver's ID card since your naturalization. Learn more in [the state's resource flyer](#).
